Mixed media on aluminum, magnesium and canvas, H: 123 ¾" x W: 151" x D: 28 3/8." Consolidated lifting paint layers, cleaned, consolidated and inpainted.

H: 35' x W: 24' Epoxy enamel and oil on aluminum honeycomb structural panels. Examined, wrote a condition report and prepared a treatment proposal.

2006

Oil painting by the French romantic painter Louis Charles Auguste Couder, 14' x 17', lined the painting onto a new canvas support with a pe-cap fabric interlayer using Beva-371 adhesive. Rolled painting on both short ends to enable retouching.

Mural by Oscar E. Berninghaus, "Commerce on the Levee in the early 80s."

2002

An 8' x 12' mural was removed from its original upson board panels which had been originally mounted with lead white adhesive. Existing tears were bonded and the canvas was lined onto a new linen support with pe-cap 7-60 fabric as interlayers and stretched onto a new wooden stretcher.

Mural by John LaFarge "The Angel of the Sun."

2002

112" x 112," tempera emulsion on paper and mounted to canvas. Designed a suction platen used to consolidate the fugitive paint layer. Removed the old lining and relined onto a new linen canvas, then stretched onto a new custom wooden expandable stretcher.
